

Lovan Appointed to ORSANCO Boards Governor's Office Announces Appointments

Frankfort, KY – On July 9, 2012 the Office of Governor Steven L. Beshear announced the appointment of Charles Ronald Lovan to two boards. Mr. Lovan was reappointed to the Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission (ORSANCO) and to serve for a term expiring June 7, 2016. Mr. Lovan was originally appointed to the Commission to represent Kentucky on April 16, 2012. The Governor's Office also appointed Mr. Lovan to the Interstate Water Sanitation Board to serve for a term expiring June 7, 2016. This appointment replaces Jeffery A. Eger, whose term has expired.

Mr. Lovan is the president/CEO of the Northern Kentucky Water District (NKWD), which was formed in 1996 when the Campbell County Kentucky Water District and the Kenton County Water District No. 1 merged. The largest water District in Kentucky, NKWD provides high quality water to over 81,000 customers in Kenton and Campbell counties.

"I'm pleased to again have the opportunity to represent Kentucky and the water treatment perspective on the ORSANCO commission," states Lovan. "I am also proud to be a new member of the Interstate Water Sanitation Board. I look forward to helping both organizations meet the challenges of their mission to control and abate pollution in the Ohio River Basin and improve water quality."

Since 1948, ORSANCO and its member states have cooperated to improve water quality in the Ohio River Basin so that the river and its tributaries can be used for drinking water, industrial supplies, and recreational purposes; and can support a healthy and diverse aquatic community. ORSANCO operates monitoring programs to check for pollutants and toxins that may interfere with specific uses of the river, and conducts special studies to address emerging water quality issues.
